

Even so, citizens and friends of Walcott have asked how they could give back to our community, and help to make a difference to better the town they love so much. A newly formed organization looks to fill that need.

The Walcott Hearts & Hands Foundation is a non-profit organization committed to enhancement, development, and beautification projects for the city of Walcott. The organization's name was coined after our city slogan of "Hearts and Hands Working Together." A board of directors has been formed to oversee the Foundation and is made up of individuals who have a desire to help make Walcott an even better community. The foundation will work hand-in-hand with local city government and will operate solely as a 501c3 nonprofit organization, which will allow all donations by individuals and businesses to be a tax deduction.

It is the mission of the Foundation to enhance the quality of life for the citizens of Walcott by promoting projects that will beautify the community and/or provide economic development. The Hearts & Hands Foundation is working very hard on their first community project. Four beautifully crafted stone signs will be constructed at key locations around Walcott. The first signs to be constructed will be two curved signs that will be located on North Main Street and offer a welcome entrance to our community. This project has been partially funded by an extremely generous donation of \$25,000 from a local resident. Look for groundbreaking work to begin in the upcoming months.



As a kick-off, we will be hosting our 1st Annual Corn Boil on August 27th at Victory Park. This community fundraiser will be in conjunction with the Walcott Chamber's "Movie in the Park." Everyone is invited and there will be food and beverages available for purchase along with delicious sweet corn. Fun will start at 6:00 p.m. and the movie will be shown at dusk. Bring your lawn chair and join us for a great evening!





Ingredients

- 2 cups uncooked egg noodles
- 1/2 pound lean ground beef
- 1 onion, chopped
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- 1 green bell pepper, chopped
- 1 cup sliced pepperoni sausage
- 16 ounces pizza sauce
- 4 tablespoons milk
- 1 cup shredded mozzarella cheese

Directions

Cook noodles according to package directions. Preheat oven to 350° F. In a medium skillet over medium-high heat, brown the ground beef with the onion, garlic and green bell pepper. Drain excess fat. Stir in the noodles, pepperoni, pizza sauce and milk, and mix well. Pour this mixture into a 2-quart casserole dish. Bake at 350 degrees F (175 degrees C) for 20 minutes, top with the cheese, then bake for 5 to 10 more minutes.


