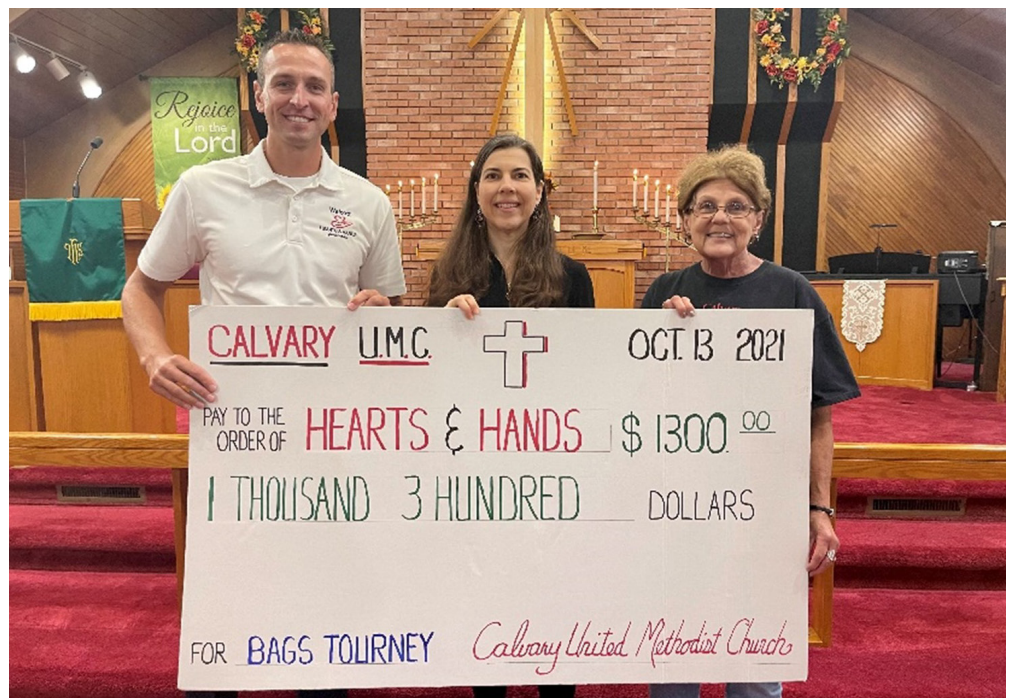
The bags tournament is Outreach Ministry for the church, used to beautify and develop the Walcott community.

Fall Curbside Leaf and Brush Collection

Leaf collection: Tuesdays and Fridays

Brush collection: Wednesdays

- Leaf and brush collection should be at the curb by 8 a.m.
- Leaves should be in bags and tied shut. Do not mix trash, branches, or other yard waste with the leaves.
- Branches should not be larger than 6” in diameter and 4’ in length. Smaller sticks must be tied or placed in a container to be emptied.
- Leaf and brush collection will end on Nov. 23.

Leaves, garden vegetation, grass, and brush may also be disposed of at the compost area. Please be considerate and follow the signs and do not leave bags at the compost area.

Alert Iowa

In conjunction with Scott County, the City of Walcott is participating in the Alert Iowa system to send official, real-time alerts to the public. Residents can sign-up for alerts which can include weather-related information, urgent messaging groups, and city options including urgent (snow emergency, water main breaks, street closures, etc.) or non-urgent (trash collection, hydrant flushing, misc., etc.).

You can sign-up online through a web opt-in page for Scott County, visit scottcountyiowa.gov/ema/alert-iowa or download the Smart911 app. If you do not have a smartphone or internet, you can go to the library for free access to the internet to sign-up. If you need help signing up and are 60 years old or older you can reach out to Milestones Area Agency on Aging for support with questions and answers, registering an account, and ongoing management of that account. Contact them by calling (855) 410-6222, between 8 a.m. – 4:30 p.m., Monday – Friday.

Personal information provided to Alert Iowa is private and only used to notify you for official communications and to support emergency services. A variety of “opt-in” mechanisms are available to ensure you get just the messages you want to receive, delivered via the devices and communications modes you choose.
