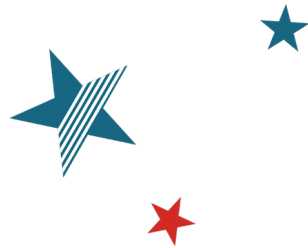

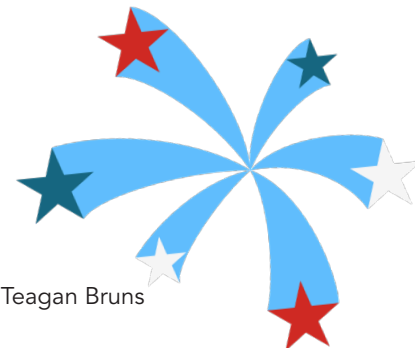

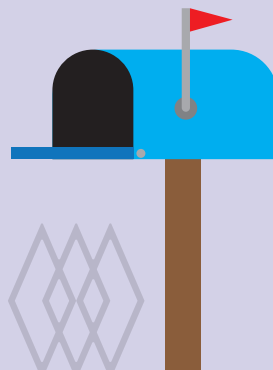

- Judging begins at 11:30 a.m.
- Pie auction will begin at approximately 2:30 p.m.
- Grand prize is chosen between the 1st place senior and junior winners. Grand prize winner will receive an additional \$50 in prize money (pie dish will not be given this year).

Golf Cart Permits

To ride a golf cart on Walcott city streets you must have a permit issued by the Police Department. These require annual renewals. You may obtain a permit application at City Hall or from our website – <http://www.cityofwalcott.com>. All drivers must sign the application and copies of driver's licenses for all drivers, current proof of insurance, and \$25 fee must accompany the application. You may return the documents to City Hall.

Drivers of golf carts, ATVs, and UTVs must have a valid driver's license and must be at least 18 years of age to ride on Walcott city streets.

West Otis Street reconstruction project

West Otis Street will be closed during reconstruction. This includes the Splash Pad area, tennis courts, and a portion of Main Street at the intersection.

City Reminders:

- If you need to contact the Police Department, please call 911 for emergencies or the Scott County Sheriff's non-emergency number at (563) 388-3904 to have an officer dispatched.
- The Walcott City Code that all grass and weeds be kept shorter than six inches.
- The Walcott City Code prohibits the use of fireworks, except for fireworks displays, by a competent operator who has obtained a permit by the City. If you have any complaints regarding illegal fireworks use, please contact the Scott County Sheriff's non-emergency number at (563) 388-3904 to have an officer dispatched.

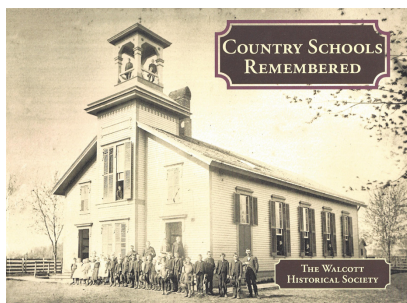

Our pictorial history books and a few original 1954/1976 history books will also be available to buy. All purchases and donations will go towards our goal of getting a larger facility to display donated treasures.

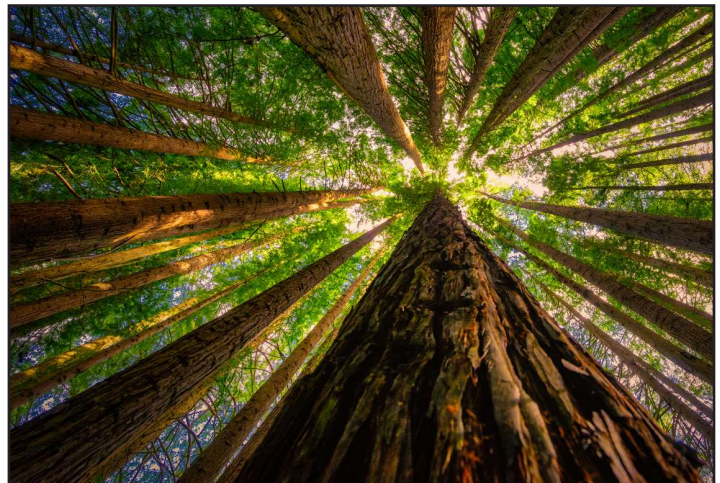
