OPERATING RESTRICTIONS The Permit Registration must be with the GOLF CART whenever said GOLF CART is in operation. To be operated on City streets only between sunrise and sunset from March 1 st to November 30 th . Golf carts that are operated on City streets shall be equipped with a slow-moving vehicle (SMV) sign and a safety flag. Golf carts shall not be operated at a speed in excess of 25 miles per hour. Operators must have a valid driver's license and be at least 18 years of age. The driver's license must be in the operator's possession. Please review the attached Golf Cart Regulation sheet. I, the undersigned, certify that I have received a copy of the golf cart regulations and understand that failure to follow them may result		
in permit revocation and/or fines.

Golf Cart Regulations

GOLF CARTS SHALL NOT BE OPERATED UPON THE FOLLOWING STREETS:

- Walcott Road (Old HWY 6/F58).
- Blue Grass Road (County Road Y-40/70th Avenue).
- Plainview Road (County Road Y-40/60th Avenue).
- Golf carts may cross said streets if: the crossing is made at an angle of approximately 90
 degrees to the direction of the street and at a place where no obstruction prevents a quick
 and safe crossing; the golf cart is brought to a complete stop before crossing the street; the
 driver/operator yields the right-of-way to all oncoming traffic which constitutes an immediate
 hazard.

UNLAWFUL OPERATION:

- No golf cart shall be operated in or on any park, playground, sidewalk, recreational bike or
 walking trail, or upon any public property except with the permission of the governing body
 thereof. Golf carts shall not be operated upon that portion of a street right-of-way between
 the curb or edge of the street paving or other surface and the sidewalk generally referred to
 as "the parking"; no golf carts shall be parked upon City sidewalks.
- No golf cart shall be operated while the operator is under the influence of intoxicating liquor, narcotics, or habit forming drugs; no person shall operate a golf cart in a careless, reckless, or negligent manner endangering the person or property of another or causing injury or damage to the same.
- No golf cart shall carry more passengers than the golf cart is designed to accommodate; the
 driver and/or passenger(s) on a golf cart shall ride on a permanent seat which is designed to
 be a part of the golf cart and permanently attached thereto.
- Golf carts shall only be operated upon City streets during the hours between sunrise and sunset, and during the months of March through November.
- Operator must have a valid driver's license, that is carried on said operator and be at least
 18 years of age; golf cart permit must be in the golf cart during operation.

EQUIPMENT: Golf carts operated upon City streets shall be equipped with a minimum of the following safety features:

- A slow-moving vehicle sign; golf carts shall not be operated at a speed in excess of 25 MPH.
- A bicycle safety flag, the top of which shall be a minimum of five feet from ground level and a minimum of two feet above the highest point of the golf cart.
- Adequate brakes: rear view mirror.

VIOLATION AND PENALTY: Persons violating golf cart regulations imposed by the City Code of Ordinances shall be subject to a suspension or revocation as follows:

- One written violation within a 12-month period, the suspension of the permit or operating privileges for a period of two months.
- Two written violations within a 12-month period, the suspension of the permit or operating privileges for a period of two years.
- Three written violations within a 12-month period, permanent revocation of the permit or operating privileges.
- Any person whose permit or operating privilege is under suspension or revocation and is found operating a golf cart within the City of Walcott shall be subject to prosecution as a simple misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be subject to a fine of five hundred dollars (\$500).
- A permit holder who permits a person whose operating privileges to operate a golf cart with
 the City of Walcott are suspended, revoked or who otherwise does not qualify to operate a
 golf cart within the City, shall be subject to prosecution as a simple misdemeanor and upon
 conviction shall be subject to a fine of two hundred dollars (\$200), and the golf cart permit
 shall be suspended for a period of two months.
