Compost Area

The City Compost Facility, located at the west end of Cedar Lane Drive, is open daily for City of Walcott residents only. Accepted materials include leaves, grass clippings, garden vegetation, and brush. Please remember that all materials must be removed from bags before disposal. Illegal dumping of garbage, electronics, and other debris is strictly prohibited. Facility rules are posted at the entrance for your reference.

Brush Collection & Grass

Please place your yard brush curbside for City pick-up every Wednesday. We also kindly remind residents that blowing grass clippings into the street is against City ordinance; it creates slippery hazards for motorists and cyclists and clogs our storm drains. Residents of Walcott are reminded that Walcott City Code requires that grass and weeds be kept shorter than 6 inches.

Walcott Weather Alert Siren Signals

A steady tone for three minutes is used to alert citizens who are outdoors of an imminent hazard and prompt them to go indoors, take shelter, and seek further information.

Weather alert sirens will be sounded for:

- Tornadoes
- Thunderstorms with winds 70 mph or greater
- Golf ball-sized hail or larger

Weather alert sirens may be sounded multiple times during the threat.

The weather alert siren is tested on the first Tuesday of each month at 10 a.m.

- Exterior Work: Roofing, siding, fences, pools, and sheds.
- Interior Work: Remodeling or structural repairs.
- Systems: Electrical, mechanical (HVAC), and plumbing installations or repairs.
